The 21-storey Tokio Marine Centre with expressed exo-skeletal structural frame makes its presence felt in the Central Business District in a subtle yet powerful way. The skewed and canted skeleton expands to cathedral-like volumes and spaces at the sky lobby, framing stunning tower top view of the cities. The slanting columns form a series of rigid planes on 3 sides of the plan and help with the torsional stiffness of the tower which has an eccentric core abutting the party wall. This offers a completely column-free floor plate with a variety of views out depending on the floor level and location within each level.
